- Guiding Principles: The NSCL is committed to providing a climate that fosters respect for all those involved in our activities. Introduction to the Amendments, Lexi

- This is an introduction to the proposition, all amendments are to the NSCL Bylaws, and all amendments are subject to ACL Board of Governors for approval
- Proposition I:
 - This amends NSCL Bylaws Article VI to codify practices, procedures, and the creation of the Ethics Committee as well as establishing means of appointing members and chartering

The proposed amendment is intentionally vague but relatively solid in form to permit for a variety of functions on the part of the Ethics Committee, and is intended to provide a broad structure for an as of yet uncodified system of the committee

- Prior to Discussion: As a courtesy to the value of all members' time, and to the numerous other activities undertaken by the SCL at convention, we will limit contributions from

each member to a single comment in tomorrow's Amendments Discussion, unless time and circumstances shall allow for additional comments
