- Proposed NSCL Bylaws Article VI.5
  - Section 5. Ethics Committee. The Executive Board, with the advice and consent of the Advisor, shall appoint, from applications solicited at least annually, an Ethics Committee that will promote an environment welcoming and safe for all members; maintain and revise the NSCL Code of Conduct as needed; and review and investigate reported violations of the NSCL Code of Conduct, and advise the Executive Board and National Committee as necessary on the resolution of such reports. The committee shall adopt a charter, subject to Executive Board approval, specifying committee officers, member terms, and other procedures as necessary to complete its duties.
